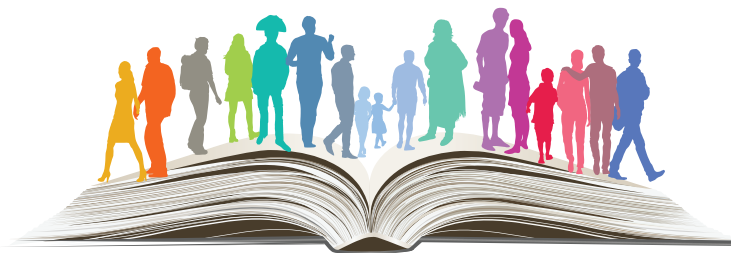
## WHAT IS MARYLAND DAY?
